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## ABSTRACT

This movie is chosen to be analyzed because of the important moral values which can be applied to real life situation. The purpose of this research is divided into two.

The first aim is to find out the moral values which can be taken from “*Children of Heaven*” movie in order that it can give benefits to young learners and the second purpose is to analyze the advantage from the movie of “*Children of Heaven*” by Majid Majidi. This research uses descriptive qualitative method. Descriptive qualitative research is best suited to address a research problem which does not know the variables need to be explored. The primary data of this research is the script of “*Children of Heaven*” movie by Majid Majidi.

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

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# CHAPTER I

EFL. Every movie has their own uniqueness that can be taken as a moral value. There are some studies which are related to the research. Some previous analysis relevant to this research, the first a study which analyzed Moral Value in “47 Ronin” movie. Based on the research findings of this review, the researcher considers those moral principles found in the film "47 Ronin" such as: generosity, openness and appreciation, self-confidence, commitment, integrity, constructive outlook, persistence, ambition and bravery, inspiration, self-respect.<sup>8</sup> The next research related to this study is “An Analysis of Moral Values in “Madagascar 3” movie. In this research study 's analysis, it can be inferred that through the Madagascar film, the researcher found universal principles for students to gain further inspiration, positive incentives and character building.<sup>9</sup> Furthermore, another research of Muslim Moral Quality of "How to Train Your Dragon" series indicates that several moral values that can be implemented in community, including strength, devotion and empathy, persistence, compassion and friendliness, don't ever

## CHAPTER II

### LITERATURE REVIEW

#### A. Moral's Concept

As discussed in the background of the problem, one of important aspects that a movie should have is moral value which is going to be discussed in this study. Furthermore, the author will analyze the moral value of *Children of Heaven* movie by Majid Majidi which in the movie, is there any moral value that people can apply for their daily life? And are they positive or negative? Before that, better to find out the definition of moral value itself.

As stated in chapter one, one message is delivered to the movie, and the viewer must identify it. The benefits of movie include increasing students' motivation, enhancing students' oral and communication skills, and developing their cultural awareness thereby allowing for a more authentic language learning experience.<sup>11</sup> Moral is a word which has relation with behavior. Moral shows good and evil, including: deeds, actions, obligations and courtesy. Moral is also used to assess the limits of a characteristic, personality, beliefs or behavior worth stating right, bad, better or poor.<sup>12</sup>

Sometimes the terms "Moral" and "Ethical" are mostly used as phrases. The Greek "Ethos" stems from ethics and ethics, meaning use, personality, and personal nature. Morality and values come from the Latin, meaning traditions, etiquette and personality.<sup>13</sup> The principles (moralistic believe) do not readily alter. But certain perceptions from ordinary life do consider the

way we view them. This is what defines generic from moralistic trust: general believe, while fundamentally constant, fluctuates.<sup>14</sup>

Moral can be assumed as the goodness that can be taken to be applied in our daily life. Morality involves (1) ideas concerning person's essence, (2) ideas on values, of what is acceptable or admirable or deserving or seeking for the sake of it, (3) laws pointing forth what can be achieved and (4) motivations that motivate one to take the right path or the wrong path. As adults, we understand that we'll be selfless, that we must not utter lies.<sup>15</sup>

Moral challenges require either actions and personality, and occur as existence confronts people with problems including "what can I do (or not do)?" ", "How am I going to act? "What sort of individual will I be?" "Moral questions are unavoidable and appear in all ways and dimensions.<sup>16</sup>

Moral is concerned to humans' principles of good and bad. Morality is the moral which has relation to discourse, statement or lesson.<sup>17</sup> It means that moral is related to the human behavior which be applied to the society. Moral impulses are a central aspect of our individual moral system, shaping the relationship among moral values and moral actions.<sup>18</sup>

This is not for others that we must apply the principles we have already had. We live in a society that has to conform with the rules that exist in the culture. It's meant we were considering making decent values. It isn't for our own gain, but for stability to be achieved in community. Moral feelings constitute an essential but frequently ignored feature of our sensible human framework.

On the background of the preceding description, this can be inferred that what is right or wrong in our acts and feelings, and what is positive and evil about being who we really are, is a human effort. It can be formed by the world in which people live in a community and can influence how we behave in our lifestyles.

## **B. Value's Concept**

The word "values" may imply that decisions of good and bad, high and grounded, a just unfair, and more personal interests are valuable as people come to recognize them. Quality is something that is of importance to us, something which we are searching for, something which is satisfying, something which is respected, or something that is nice at low quality. Quality with outstanding interpretation.

Value is a concept which either performs wellbeing or avoids harm. This is something that encourages one to do something or that which stops injuries.<sup>20</sup> Afterward, values seen as moral norms of the behavior patterns of living creatures in social structure. It is sort of a human attribute being extended to environmental factors. It is passed on to a circumstantial element and relies on the factual decision.<sup>21</sup>

The researcher believes that beliefs define what must be regarded as good or bad based on the concept above. Principles are the laws by which we make judgments about right and wrong,

### **C. Concept of Moral Value**

Moral value is a value to distinguish from other qualities. Any value, if it has a connection to other values, will get quality. Honesty is an example of moral value, this attribute has no meaning unless implemented alongside other values. Moral Value is a person and an item connection. Thing is important, since it is useful. Moral worth refers to the importance of intent. Loyalty is a moral principle, but it must be extended to other ideals of society in general, such as husbands and wives affection.

Moral value is quality or importance which has to do with people's nature and evilness and, in particular, with the goodness and badness of such qualities of personality and underlying motivations by virtue of which people are fundamentally good or evil. Moral worth, then, is the importance of community of the fairness or evilness of human nature. It is linked to the morality of civilization. If they have strong moral values, which means that a positive moral value has had a very strong effect on their lives. Moral values surrounding human appearance and behavior. Moral values are learned to be fully implemented by people in society in order to improve the growth of personality and encourage good moral education and mental wellbeing of the people.<sup>22</sup>

In addition, moral values are also related to human behavior. In culture, people can judge someone of good quality because they have positive conduct, character.

### **D. Characteristics of Moral Value**

There are four features of moral value. There are as follows:

1. Moral value is related with responsibility

Moral value is related to duty, but besides moral value, other qualities may also be mentioned. Moral value allows people considered to be wrong or right, so they have a duty. This indicates that moral value is tied to obligation. Moral value can only be valid in reality if it becomes the duty of the individual concerned.

2. Moral value is related with pure heart

All qualities are required to make something meaningful. It should be practiced, because of its convincing strength. For example, the esthetic value should be learned, the production of music must be performed or otherwise. After that, art needs to be seen, music needs to be listened to, and film needs to be seen as well. It can be appealed from a pure heart to make moral meaning possible. One of the unique features of universal values is that this meaning would have an impact on the speech of a good heart that blames us if it contradicts moral value and praises us.

3. Obligation

Moral value obliges an essential element that cannot be undermined. Other principles need to be true and acknowledged, e.g. artistic meaning. Still inactive people can't be blamed for that. Moral integrity obliges one to do so without the obligation to use it. For example, honesty tells one to honestly talk about anything and not tell people lies.

4. Formality

Although moral value is the top value that we need to consider, it is not the top value without any other value. Moral beliefs did not differentiate from those beliefs. For example, a seller presents moral values at once, with financial benefits attached. Moral values are nothing more than values. It's a type of formality.

## E. Types of Moral Value

There are types of moral value, as follow:

### 1. Courage

Courage is confronting something involving possible unpleasant or devastating results) or is used (as hardship) with self-control and mastery of fear, and often with a specific goal in mind. Courage is able to confront danger or resist discomfort or hardship without giving in to fear. Courage emerges from, or suggests or mastery of fear and intellectual use of abilities, particularly under extreme stress.<sup>23</sup>

### 2. Enthusiasm

Enthusiasm is a deep emotion of feeling in the name of the cause of the subject, something that encourages or is sought or perceived with passionate enthusiasm or idealism. A believer is a person who is or assumes that he or she is motivated or influenced by god or energy, or a person who is visionary, excessive, or too jealous with his or her religious beliefs or emotions.<sup>24</sup> While passionate regarding optimism or inspired lecturing. Enthusiasm is having an ardent, receptive, receptive, temperamental, or a tendency to give oneself entirely to what's in one's concern or pleasure.<sup>25</sup>

### 3. Kindheartedness

Kindheartedness is the concentrated manifestation of personality beauty and social beauty.<sup>26</sup> Kindness is comparable to what has been provided or earned. Kind is more often at the disposal of sympathy and helpfulness. Kind stresses the appearance of a compassionate, useful personality,

emotions or impulse (a kind person with a kind interest in another's problem). pKindness is from a sympathetic personality. Kindness is a real display of social beneficence in community activities.<sup>27</sup>

#### 4. Honesty

Honesty is defined as a “complete disclosure” of information, which is verbally communicating to the other all of the situationally relevant knowledge, “fact”, or findings which the actor is cognizant.<sup>28</sup> Honesty is an appreciable personality; equality and straightness of behavior or compliance to the facts. Honesty is free from deception or hypocrisy.<sup>29</sup>

#### 5. Love and Affection

Love has fallen because of affection and fallen as a guide affection for (God). Affection is a kind emotion of delicate binding: passion, goodness, will. Affection is a deep emotion or enthusiasm (e.g. frustration, fear or anger); a state of awareness ( e.g. enjoyment or dissatisfaction); a turning of mind: a thought or unconscious instinct that drives the mind: tendency, temperament;<sup>30</sup> loyalty may be defined as a singular concept, usually as an attitude toward the loyalty object or as repeatpatronage behaviour; alternatively, the definition may combine attitude and behaviour in either an additive or an interactive expression.<sup>31</sup>

## 11. Strong Faith

Messages would be processed more easily because of the quality of the audiovisual content.<sup>44</sup> Thus movie has a very important role in life. ### **1. Action**

### **2. Adventure**

This adventure genre film is usually themed with the search for something missing, can be a treasure or even an island. Adventures in the jungle, desert, or other places are presented beautifully.<sup>48</sup>

### **3. Comedy**

Comedy genre films generally convey stories in a light and simple way, and deliberately made to invite the excitement of

Since these movies are based on negative or frightening elements, these movies are among the most challenging genres.<sup>51</sup>

#### 6. Epics/Historical

Epic films take on real incidents or fictional occurrences, myths, legends or people called heroes, with spectacular scenery and fancy outfits. This movie is always beautiful and impressive<sup>52</sup>

## 7. Westerns

## 8. Romance

Romantic film makes powerful and romantic story lines in which people through face difficulties such as medical condition, injuries, family problems, etc. Most romantic stories have a happy ending in which love lasts forever in the lives of the characters. The themes of such films are first-hand love, one-sided love, obsessed love, spiritual love, romantic love, harmful love, tragic love, etc.<sup>54</sup>

## 9. Thriller

The key aspect of the thriller film is its realistic variations in the mood or mind of the viewer about the actors in the movie. These films offer a wonderful blend of tension, surprise, unexpected twists in the plot, excitement, and panic. The specialty of this is that it holds the preconceived idea of the viewer until the climax of the film, because these films are never out of the market. Thriller movies include mystery, suspense, important criminal cases, etc.<sup>55</sup>

## 10. Science Fiction

Science fiction explores the aware rather than the implicit, speculates about technology, tricks and the optimized future,

## H. Concept of Movie as the Media in Education

Movie is a series of images reflected onto a screen of appropriate speed to produce an illusion of movement and consistency. There are several forms of film, such as drama, action, horror, animation, history, comedy, romantic and science fiction. Many of the films are derived from the actual story in the world and others are adapted from books or novels. Movie is going to give us a message like morals, inspiration, belief, knowledge, etc.<sup>57</sup> Movie has experienced rapid development along with the development of existing technology. Movie have various roles, besides being a means of entertainment, films can also function as learning media.

Movie is a communication tool that really helps the effective learning process. What is seen by the eye and heard by the ear, is faster and easier to remember than what can only be read or only heard.<sup>58</sup> It means that the use of movie media as a learning medium or source of learning, can help the audience

establish a more lively communication and interaction, so that the message of learning to be conveyed can be achieved better and perfectly.
